## TRAINING COURSE IN MALAGA, SPAIN

From June 10–15, 2025, 20 youth workers from Spain, Italy, Lebanon, and Jordan gathered in Málaga for an immersive training course. Through interactive workshops, participants explored non-formal education techniques—such as public speaking and digital storytelling—to empower young migrants. Attendees co-developed a practical Toolkit, tested activities with migrant youth, and strengthened skills in facilitation, intercultural dialogue, and digital empowerment. The results will be applied locally during upcoming workshops in each partner country, ensuring wider impact for integration initiatives. # UPCOMING LOCAL WORKSHOPS: TRAINED YOUTH OPERATORS IN ACTION WITH YOUNG MIGRANTS

As the Devmigra project moves forward, each partner will soon launch a 5-day local training course for 10 youth workers (aged 20–30), combining experienced trainers from migration centers and newer operators. Guided by facilitators, participants will co-design the first draft of our Toolkit of Non-Formal Education activities, later tested in workshops with young migrants. These sessions will create practical tools—such as public speaking and digital storytelling modules—to strengthen young migrants’ skills and visibility. We invite organizations, stakeholders, and anyone interested to follow our updates, join the process, and contact us to take part in the upcoming workshops.

## CONSORTIUM E-MEETING

On March 24, 2025, the DEVMIGRA partners held a virtual meeting to review progress and strategize the final six months of the project. With the end date approaching, discussions focused on:

- Tracking completed tasks and pending objectives
- Finalizing and publishing project results
- Ensuring all results (including the DEVMIGRA Manual & Toolkit) meet quality standards
